SUBJECT: INVITATION TO JOIN THE AFRICAN CURRICULUM ASSOCIATION UNDER CESA CURRICULUM CLUSTER AT AU

Delegates from Africa and beyond converged from 28th to 31st May 2018 at Entebbe Imperial Golf View Hotel in Uganda at a conference to deliberate on curriculum for sustainable learning. One major outcome of the conference was the rebirth of the African Curriculum Organisation, established in 1976 by Member States of the African Union Organisation (AUO) in Nigeria, Lagos during the Conference of African Ministers of Education, but with a new name, The African Curriculum Association (ACA).

The African Curriculum Association (ACA) is a registered continental organization focusing on curriculum development, implementation and assessment as its core mandate to improve the quality of education in Africa. The association's secretariat is in Uganda and is housed at National Curriculum Development Centre Kyambogo.

In December 2018, ACA was designated by the African Union (AU) and member states in attendance, with the exclusive responsibility of coordinating the newly established African Union Curriculum Cluster. The Continental Education Strategy for Education (CESA) thematic cluster was established to ensure that continental curriculum issues are incorporated and equally addressed, similarly to other issues in different CESA thematic clusters at the African Union.

The main role of ACA is to coordinate and support African Curriculum interventions towards the common African vision to ensure a more Afri-centric, quality, inclusive, relevant, responsive and transformative curriculum.

I therefore have the distinguished honour to invite you and your organisation to join the African Curriculum Association as a member. Key membership benefits, both at individual and country level, include amongst others, the following:

- a) Strengthening the Curriculum Centres and organisations through providing international best practices
- b) Establishing networks of communications among curriculum development centres and partner organisations with ACA serving as a clearing house for the exchange of

- d) Engaging in the production and exchange of curriculum materials across the continent
- e) Carrying out joint curriculum research programmes as well as the exchange of research information

- g) Engaging in exchange programmes between curriculum specialists and other personnel

Involving in consultancy work relating to curriculum planning, development implementation, assessment and evaluation

- h) Establishing a working relationship with similar organizations in various parts of the world
- i) Engaging in designing, development, and implementation of education programmes initiated by member organisation
- j) Receiving information about curriculum related conferences, workshops, benchmarks and trainings

Membership is open to any National Curriculum Centre, Research and Education Network in the area of curriculum development or related fields in African Member States, education institutions/ ministries/ government institutions as well as inter-governmental and non-governmental organizations and individuals.
